Please, read the following explanations before submitting an abstract.

The METEAU conference features 30 min oral contributions including 5 min for questions for the invited speakers and 20 min including 5 min discussion for the oral presentations. The abstracts are to be sent to:

The layout of the abstract is maximum one page A4 with 2.5 cm borders on all sides. The font is Trebuchet MS, 10pt, single-spaced, full justified, with a maximum of 400 words in total. All acronyms must be defined. Equations, figures and tables can be used, if desired. The committee reserves the right to reformat the abstracts not following the layout if necessary, which might result in detriment of the content. Please submit a word document, which must be named after the surname of the presenting author. The details of the layout are given in the template. If you follow the given format, you facilitate the work of the committee substantially.

While submitting the abstract you must identify the presenting author, who normally also acts as the corresponding author for the abstract. In case these two persons are different, only the full contact details of the corresponding author are needed. Note that each presenting author must register to the conference prior to the early-bird deadline on September 15th, 2010.

Posters will be viewed during one of Poster Sessions for each working groups. There are going to be 4 poster sessions in total, scheduled in the afternoon, at which the authors are requested to be present for questions and discussion. Selected posters will have a 3 minutes time to be presented orally.

Size. - Poster Boards 0.84 m wide and 1.19 m high will be available. Material to fix the posters will be provided.
